2 What data do we collect?

ProjectPharm collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)

3 How do we collect your data?

You directly provide ProjectPharm with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Complete the contact form
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

ProjectPharm may also have recorded your data from emails you sent us, or from business cards you handed over personally

4 How will we use your data?

ProjectPharm collects your data so that we can:

- Process your inquiries and manage your account.
- Email you with information, offers, or other topics we think you might like.

ProjectPharm will not share your data with any other company or individual

5 How do we store your data?

ProjectPharm securely stores your data in our address database, which is secured by Microsoft. All servers used for storing our data are located in the European Union.

ProjectPharm will keep your until you request us to delete them, or until our services ill terminate.

We may delete the data earlier, if we believe that there's no good reason to keep them.

6 Marketing

Although ProjectPharm is currently not distributing marketing information, we may do so in future.

If you have agreed or will agree to receive marketing information, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop ProjectPharm from contacting you for marketing purposes or giving your data to other members of ProjectPharm.

7 What are your data protection rights?

ProjectPharm would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access:

You have the right to request ProjectPharm for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification:

You have the right to request that ProjectPharm correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request ProjectPharm to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure:

You have the right to request that ProjectPharm erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing:	You have the right to request that ProjectPharm restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
The right to object to processing:	You have the right to object to ProjectPharm's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
The right to data portability:	You have the right to request that ProjectPharm transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please contact us
